Mr. Hansen is dedicated to the investment advisory activities of Thrivent's Clients. Mr. Hansen does not have any other business activities.

Item 5 – Additional Compensation

Mr. Hansen is dedicated to the investment advisory activities of Thrivent's Clients. Mr. Hansen does not receive any additional forms of compensation.

At TAN, Mr. Hansen receives compensation for providing investment advisory services that is primarily based on a percentage of fees charged on assets under management for investment management services and/or a percentage of fees charged for financial planning and consulting services.

Mr. Hansen may, from time to time, receive additional compensation or other economic benefits; such as, sales awards, recruiting and training support services, expense reimbursement, software, bonuses or non-cash compensation (e.g., attend sales conferences and other recognition events) for providing investment advisory products or services.

Mr. Hansen may be eligible to receive compensation for referring individuals who become Advisory Persons of TAN. The compensation paid to the referring Advisory Persons is based on the referred individuals becoming Advisory Persons of TAN and revenue from investment advisory fees earned by them.

In certain instances, TAN may provide for a cash bonus or other economic benefit to Mr. Hansen based on the number of new clients that purchase certain eligible products and services, including advisory products and services. This additional compensation is based on the number of Mr. Hansen's new clients who become members of Thrivent Financial for Lutherans because the clients bought a membership-eligible product, retention of assets, and or their sales volume of specific products and services

Item 6 – Supervision

Thrivent has implemented a Code of Ethics, an internal compliance document that guides each Supervised Person in meeting their fiduciary obligations to Clients of Thrivent. Further, Thrivent is subject to regulatory oversight by various agencies. These agencies require registration by Thrivent and its Supervised Persons. As a registered entity, Thrivent is subject to examinations by regulators, which may be announced or unannounced. Thrivent is required to periodically update the information provided to these agencies and to provide various reports regarding the business activities and assets of the Advisor.
